Special Meeting of the Board of Education – Board Room #300 Wednesday, June 24, 2020 5:30 PM

The meeting of the Suring School Board was called to order by Board President Sleeter.

Pledge of Allegiance

There was no public input at this time

Remove hiring a Social Worker for 2020-2021 and an English Teacher for 2020-2021 from the agenda was approved. COVID policies and procedures were discussed. A discussion took place over opening school as of July 6, 2020 and the parameters that would need to be put in place to make that happen.

Opening the building to a limited number of staff and athletes to use the weight room and small gym with screening protocols was recommended. No public access to the building at this time was suggested. A meeting will be set up with coaches explaining the procedures that will need to be followed if they bring athletes into the building. Pre-screening at home, waivers, and screening at the door will be required to enter the building. Social distancing will be implemented. The school district will not allow any affiliation with camps outside of the Suring School District building, or provide transportation, equipment or funding from the district's activity funds.

Graduation set for July 11, 2020 will be postponed until August 8, 2020. Board Members determined that the district is not ready to bring all those people into the building at the present time. The district will start with opening up the facility to athletes and coaches, following the parameters put in place, taking little steps to learn as we go.

Summer school was also discussed. Mrs. Casper will be in contact with Jen Breed and the busing company to continue to move forward with the possibility of swim lessons at the Bond Center and offering some academic classes in August depending on numbers. Expectations will be put in place and if there are limitations, it will be on a first come, first serve basis.

A Back To School Planning Form will be developed to send to every family. The form will be required, not optional, to get an idea what parents feel return to school in the fall will look like. If the form is not returned, follow-up calls will be made to families to get their opinion.

Motion by Regal, seconded by Lally to approve COVID policies and procedures for re-opening school, summer school and the facility use. Carried 6-0.

Motion by Lally, seconded by Seibert to convene in Closed Session if approved by roll call vote of the Board. Carried 6-0.
