Suring High School

What is Title 1

Title 1 is a federally funded program used to support students in building academic skills. At the high school level we focus on building not only the students functional reading and math levels but also ensure adequate progress to graduation.

How is a student selected for Title 1 services

Students at the high school level are identified in need extra support through class grades, teacher observations, and credit completion.

School Wide Goal for Title 1

By the 2024-2025 school year the Suring High school will decrease the number of students not on track to graduate, "At-Risk", by 5%.

- 2023-2024 - 11 of 132
- Projected 2024-2025 - 4 or 132

Rational for the School Wide Goal

- While still recovering from the COVID-19 slump in credits earned from early in students high school career supported is need to help students build the skills they missed when on virtual learning.
- During previous school years after returning from virtual learning teachers struggled to support learning gaps whilst still providing grade level instruction. Do to the extreme variation in skill levels additional support was recognized as a need for a specific group of students not making adequate progress towards graduation.

Current and Future Steps we are taking to meet the Goal

During the 2023-2024 school year Multiple teachers will be working with small groups of student who are not on track for graduation providing them with organizational and academic support. In addition to this all subject teachers will work with students not passing their current class during 8th hour weekly to build students skills in their respective subject areas.

Parent/Guardian Involvement in Title 1

The success of the Title 1 program is dependent on the cooperation between the school and each students parent/guardian. Please look for information to be sent home with your student during first quarter and at parent teacher conferences. During our annual literacy night we will also have a parent meeting to discuss the Title 1 program and support we can provide parents/guardians to help their student at home.
