

Suring Summer School 2017

Take a look and see what fun and educational things you can do during the summer of 2017 at Suring School. The registration form is located in the back of the booklet. The booklet and registration forms will be available on the school website.

If you sign your child up for swimming lessons during week 3 and 4 a \$20 deposit per child will be required. This deposit is refunded when/if your child completes 6 out of the 8 swim lessons. Swim lessons at the Bond Center is a wonderful opportunity for Suring students but these lessons and the transportation to them cost money. Suring is charged the full lesson price for every student who attends for even just one day. We hope that every student who signs up for lessons takes full advantage of the skills they will learn and attend a minimum of 6 out of 8 days. Checks are preferred and should be attached to the registration form.

Some things to keep in mind while choosing classes with your child:

- Transportation to and from summer school classes will **NOT** be provided by the school district.
- Suring will be serving a FREE breakfast and lunch each day of class. Your child does not need to be enrolled in a class to eat. Breakfast will be served from 7:45 am - 8:15 pm. Lunch will be served from 12:15 pm - 12:45 pm.
- ALL K-12 classes will run from 8:15 am - 12:15 pm. Please have your child to school no earlier than 7:45 am if they will be eating breakfast or 8:10 am if they will not be eating breakfast at school.
- If your child has any food allergies or other health concerns that summer school staff should know, it is a parent's responsibility to inform staff of these issues on the first day of each new class.
- Snack/supply fee for each class is due the first day of that class. Checks can be made out to Suring School.
- All classes will use the front entrance of the school, DOOR 1. Location of class will be posted on the front doors of school.
- You will receive your sign-up sheet back before the end of the school year. This is your confirmation that the classes your child signed up for will be running this summer. If a class is crossed off it means that the class will not be running due to lack of enrollment. If a class is full you will be informed of this on your sheet also. If your summer plans change please call the school to have your child removed from the class list.
