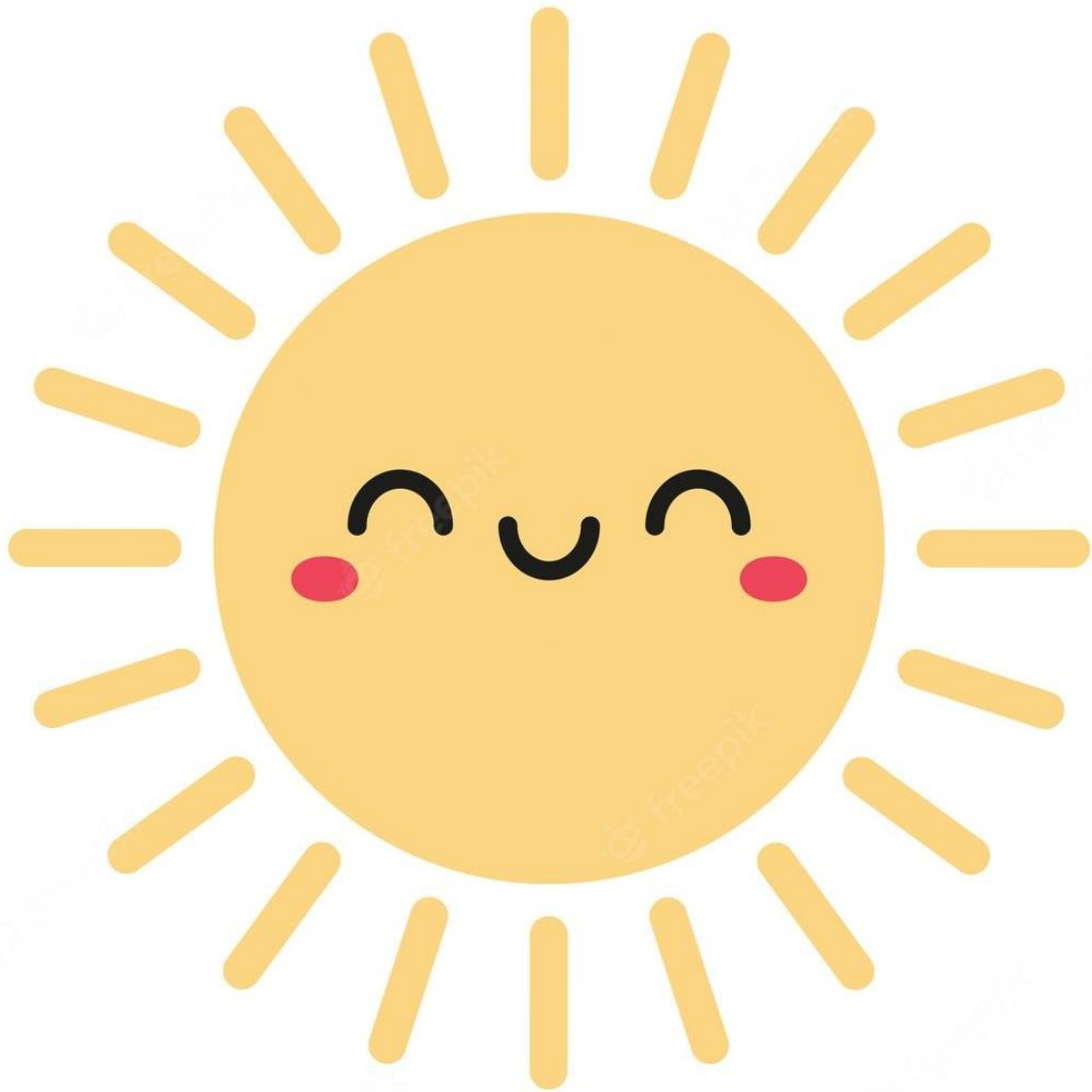

SURING SUMMER SCHOOL 2024

Take a look and see what fun and educational things you can do during the summer of 2024 at Suring School. The registration form is located in the back of the booklet. Some things to keep in mind while choosing classes with your child:

- Transportation to and from summer school are **NOT** provided by the school district.
- When choosing courses, please choose based off of the grade your child is entering for the 2024-2025 academic year.
- ALL elementary classes will run from 8:00am-12:00pm. Please have your child to school **no earlier than 7:55am each day**.
- Students will use the front entrance of the school, Door 1. Location of class will be posted on the front doors of school.
- This year, **FREE** breakfast and lunch **ARE** provided by the district for weeks **ALL** weeks of summer school, including weeks six and seven. Students can arrive at 7:45 to eat their breakfast. Lunch will be served from 12:00-12:15 each day there is classes. As for swimming lessons, they will be provided with lunch and snack. See swimming lesson page for more information.
- If your child has any food allergies or other health concerns that summer school staff should know, it is a parent's responsibility to inform staff of these issues on the first day of each new class.
- We want your student to have fun while at summer school, but we will be enforcing our school behavior policy.
- If you choose to enroll your child in summer band lessons, please write it down on the registration form. When you sign up for a week, Ms. Rennhack will contact you to schedule a finalized time.
- You will receive a sign-up sheet before the end of the school year. This is your confirmation that the class your child signed up for will be running this summer. If a class is crossed off, it means that the class will not be running due to lack of enrollment.

Please return registration to school by Friday, April 26th.
Registration forms can be turned into your child's teacher or the student office.

Additional Information Regarding Swim Lessons, ATV/Snowmobile and Hunter Safety

Swimming Lessons

If you sign your child up for swimming lessons during weeks four and five, there will be a \$25 deposit that is required for each child. **This deposit will be refunded when/if your child completes 6 out of the 8 swim lessons.** They are a wonderful opportunity for Suring students, but the transportation and lessons cost money. Suring is charged the full lesson price for every student who attends. This is even if they attend one day. We hope that every student who signs up for lessons takes full advantage of the skills they will learn and attends the minimum 6 days.

This year, swim lessons will take place at the *Pulaski Community Swimming Pool*. **Things will be a little different for swim lessons. They will run from 1:15-2:45.**

Checks are preferred for payment and can be attached to your child's registration form. These can be made out to Suring School District.

ATV & Snowmobile Safety

This is going to run a little bit differently this summer. **ATV Safety will be two days, rather than four. This will be held on June 17th and June 18th.** The final two days of that week will be a course in Snowmobile Safety instead. **The Snowmobile Safety course will take place on June 19th and June 20th of that same week.** The cost of ATV and Snowmobile Safety courses will be determined once there is a final number. If you only want to enroll in one of these, please list it on the registration form. **Just an FYI, the maximum capacity of each class is only 20 students.** First come, first serve!

Hunter Safety

This summer, Hunter Safety will **ONLY** be taking place during week three of summer school (June 24th- 27th). Again, this is something that has lots of interest, so if you are wanting your child to participate, please turn in your slips as soon as possible. Spots will be first come first serve! **There is a cost, but this will be determined once there is a final number.**
