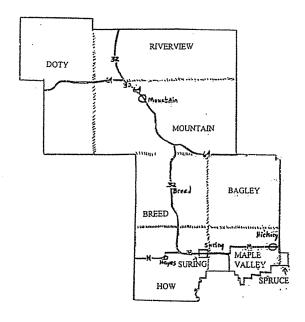

We strive to educate our students at a reasonable cost while serving the goals of society and our community. 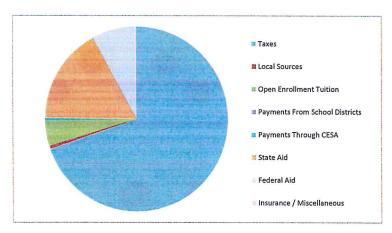

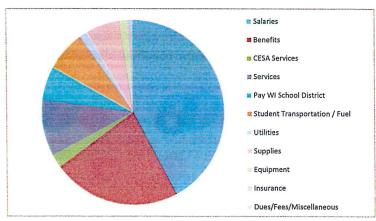
