The regular meeting of the Suring School Board was called to order by Board President Piepkorn.

Mrs. Casper shared the Suring School District Goals for 2014-2015 and how she presented them to the staff. A video, "Every Kids Needs a Champion" by Rita Pierson was watched.

Amy Kasten gave the Curriculum Report/Report Card Update which included: After-school program, Literacy audit schedule, ACT Aspire status, Agricultural classes crosswalk to science.

Laura Fisher gave the Technology Report. Fisher discussed the recent computer crash which affected the storage device that housed all the school district information.

Greg Jaeger gave the Building and Grounds Report. An update on the school forest management plan was given by Mr. Jaeger. He suggested to the Board that bids be placed for a Consultant (a certified independent forester) to update the management plan, mark trees, bid out the job and oversee logging operations. Gene School asked for the numbers from the last cutting for the next meeting. The Village of Suring baseball field will not be ready for the 2015 baseball/softball season. Our Emergency Nursing Plan is under review by St. Clare's Hospital.

Mrs. Casper gave the Food Service Report and shared the September 2014 breakfast and lunch menu.

Mrs. Casper shared the Unofficial 2014-15 student enrollment numbers.

Motion by Lundgren, seconded by Strehlow to approve both student transportation contracts for the 2014-15 school year as presented. Carried 7-0.

Mrs. Casper shared the fall athletic rosters for volleyball and basketball.

Mr. Huisman presented the Principal's Report/Athletic Report which included the in-service week recap, first day of school activities, new pickup procedures (locations and rationale), and the upcoming school events.

The Athletic Report included a reminder that the M&O Kickoff Banquet will be held September 24 at Romy's Holiday Inn at Kelly Lake. The Banquet will offer a tribute to Dave Collins for his 50 years of service to the M&O Conference. Ron Kalous (10 years as Head Golf Coach), Mitch Taylor (15 years as Head Football Coach), and Greg Lechleitner (30 years as Head Boys and Girls Track Coach) will also be recognized. This year the M&O Conference chose Suring, Gillett and Peshtigo Schools as the recipient schools which will each receive \$1,200 to donate to families in their district affected by cancer.
